

Workstation Hygiene Best Practices

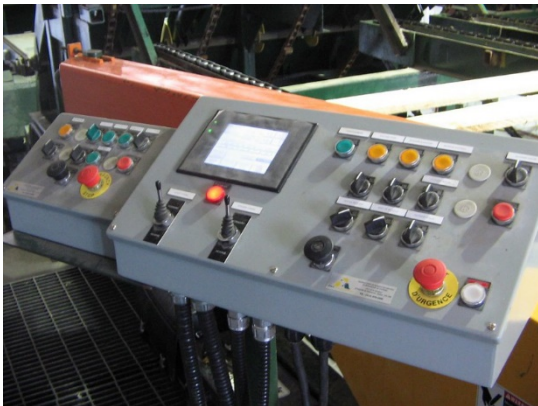
The following is a guide to help keep your workstations clean and prevent the transmission of spreadable illnesses

MOBILE EQUIPMENT

Always follow the manufacturers recommendations

Areas to clean

- Steering Wheel
- Control buttons and levers
- Seatbelt
- Hand brakes
- Mirrors



MACHINE CENTRES

- Door handles (where booths are located)
- Buttons and switches
- HMI screens
(use only approved cleaning solutions)
- VHF radio controls

HOW TO CLEAN

- Wear gloves when cleaning
- Do not pour liquid on any part of a machine
- Spray disinfecting solution onto a cleaning cloth
- Wipe down areas listed above
- Do not mix chemicals
- Discard cloth when cleanup is complete or when it becomes soiled.
